## *Review Of Written Programs And Training Records*

During the Compliance Benchmarking process, a consultant can review your written safety programs to determine if you are in compliance with applicable standards. They can also discuss your current training programs to determine if changes in training types or frequency would be beneficial. If additional training is needed, a consultant may be able to help design or deliver it.

## *Formal Report*

A few weeks after the on-site survey, you will receive a report detailing the findings. This report will include:

- Description of the cited observation
- Photo of the cited observation (where appropriate)

- Location where the observation was noted
- Regulatory standard the observation violates
- One or more possible solutions to help bring you into compliance
